- 2. President Kirk led the Pledge of Allegiance for Board Members and attendees.
- 3. Superintendent Lesher, welcomed NATIVE Board Members and meeting attendees, and introduced Woody Begay, Tuba City CTE Director.
- 4. In addition to the six Governing Board Members, the NATIVE Superintendent, the NATIVE Secretary, the NATIVE Business Manager, the NATIVE CTE Coordinator, and 2 NATIVE site CTE Directors, for a total of 12, were in attendance for all or part of the meeting
- 5. Board members Allen and Shepherd questioned the legality of the Board meeting in reference to 24 hours notice of proposed Board meeting location. Superintendent Lesher addressed Board members' concerns. Board president Kirk recommended a call to the NATIVE legal counsel for advice. NATIVE counsel Franklin Hoover stated that it was acceptable to relocate the meeting but recommended that the meeting first be convened at the original posted location (WRHS) and then take action to move it to the revised location, where it would be reconvened.
