Superintendent Lesher presented the retreat agenda. Superintendent Lesher reviewed the updated NATIVE strategic plan 2010-2015, and emphasized the importance of Central Campus enrollment to enhance state funding resources. Strategic Plan item of Marketing and suggested promotion items were shared from the Board. Board member legislative input was discussed. The Plan item on Charter school was endorsed.

Superintendent Lesher and CTE Coordinator Gilmore presented Central campus programs, and the rationale for determining Central Campus program inclusion. CTE Gilmore integrated Navajo philosophy of planning of thinking, planning, life, hope and strength in the presentation. A list of recommended staff at the Central Campus was presented and discussed. Adult education possibilities were addressed.
