- II. Jarvis Williams, Kayenta Township Manager welcomed meeting attendees.
- III. Karen Lesher, NATIVE superintendent introduced the NATIVE Board members, meeting attendees, and discussed meeting objectives.
- IV. Margaret Yazzie, NATIVE Board President shared her experience with the NATIVE District and her vision of a central campus.
- V. Frank Donald, Jr., Navajo Nation Workforce Development, presented Workforce Development's strong need for a training facility and reiterated its support for a central campus.
- VI. Walter Begay, Peabody Coal Company, remarked that Peabody Coal Company welcomes and supports the central campus initiative. Peabody Coal Company currently sends its trainees off the reservation, but the ideal is to have a local training facility such as the NATIVE central campus.
- VII. Frankie Gilmore, NATIVE CTE coordinator provided an overview of the central campus design.
- VIII. Ben Shelly, Navajo Nation Vice-President offered the support of the Navajo Nation for the NATIVE central campus, and emphasized its importance to the Navajo people.
- IX. A panel discussion was held that included Frank Donald, Jr., Walter Begay, Pauline Begay, Linda Morrow, Karen Lesher, Frankie Gilmore.
- X. On behalf of the NATIVE Governing Board, Shannon Tooke, NATIVE Board member stated that it is the Governing Board's objective to pursue funds to construct a central facility. The central campus will unify all the NATIVE courses, some of them through video distance learning network.
- XI. NATIVE Vice-President Todacheeny provided a benediction to close the meeting.
- XII. Lunch, served to all attendees, was prepared by the NATIVE District culinary arts students of Pinon High School, directed by Culinary Arts instructor Nellie McCurtain.
