Each year, NATIVE District applies for E-rate funding (Schools and Libraries Universal Service Support Mechanism) with Universal Service Administrative Company. The E-rate program provides eligible schools discounts for eligible services and products. Discounts range from 20% to 90% of the costs of eligible services and products. The E-rate program supports connectivity – the conduit or pipeline for communications using telecommunications services and/or the internet. The services and products provided are telecommunication services, internet access services, internal connections and basic maintenance. The E-rate application needs to be submitted in order for NATIVE District to be considered for the funding and discounts. In order for the application to be submitted and processed, an authorized representative or signatory must be provided.
