With the shortage of teachers, with our annual teacher salary not being at the top end and with the AZ Auditor General asking what we are doing to attract and retain teachers, this will be one thing that can be done.

We had done this teacher retention payment before using the ESSER funding (Covid) but that funding has now ended.

The amount of the teacher retention payment will be \$3,000 per year.
